OBJECTIVES

The main aim of the project is to identify business opportunities in the area of circular economy in the Cross - Border area of Greece-Bulgaria and to create a structure through which business ideas of potential entrepreneurs will be transformed into businesses.

The structure will deliver a new business approach to enhance entrepreneurship of young scientists building on three pillars: knowledge, mentoring/coaching, and networking.

The project focuses on the provision of assistant through 4 HUBs to the new entrepreneurs for the implementation of their business plans and not only the development of these plans so that the new enterprises can be operative before project's ending or 2 years after at the latest.

BACKGROUND

Young people living in both countries and especially in the programme's cross border area can boost the economic development and the prosperity of the area.

At the same time, growth of small and medium sized companies can be the gear for such a development. Circular Economy is both an opportunity and a need and corresponds to the features of the Cross Border area's economy.

In addition, the EU is working on the transition to a carbon neutral, circular economy. Circular economy offers Europe a major opportunity to increase resource productivity, decrease resource dependence and increase employment and growth.

Lastly, the co-operation within the project will highlight areas of circular economy that have the potential to grow throughout the CBC area while the significant human capital in this specific area, will be supported by experienced actors to promote growth through the creation of circular enterprises.

TARGET GROUP

The project's main target group is the qualified scientific workforce (engineers and other scientists) of the CBC area that will be assisted for the creation of their "circular business" through the ENGINE-HUBs. At least, ninety young entrepreneurs and their enterprises will receive support.

In addition, the area that will be benefited by the project is the entire CBC area by the exploitation of its workforce and the identification of the local circular economy value chains and cross-border synergies at the sector. In addition, market actors (suppliers, investors, and clients) are also targeted in order to be linked with the entrepreneurs and exploit their potential.
